Here's how your Association worked for you in 2020 to meet the transportation needs of the Greater Dulles Region:

- Conducted DATA's **Annual Transportation Roundtable** offering timely updates on transportation projects and initiatives from Fairfax, Loudoun, and Prince William Counties, VDOT, DRPT, MWAA and WMATA
- Held DATA's first **Legislative Roundtable** featuring Congressman Gerry Connolly, State Senator Jennifer Boysko, Fairfax County Board Chairman Jeff McKay, and Loudoun County Chair Phyllis Randall discussing legislation affecting regional transportation; moderated by NBC4's Adam Tuss
- Mitigated the business challenges posed by the pandemic by offering a series of **informative webinars** on how to initiate, expand, or formalize a telework program; coordinated with the Dulles Regional Chamber of Commerce and the Fairfax County Economic Development Authority's Multi-Cultural Chamber Alliance
- **Increased communication** through bi-weekly *DATA* alerts keeping members updated on rapidly changing developments in transportation policy
- Through the federal Enhanced Mobility grant, **recruited volunteer drivers** to deliver much-needed food supplies from area food banks to the elderly and to disabled citizens
- Through a special Fairfax County grant (funded through the CARES act) and a grant from the Reston Bicycle Club, DATA staff and volunteers **distributed bi-lingual safe bicycling information fliers and bike lights** to essential workers throughout the greater Reston area
- Continued to assist parents from schools already enrolled in the SchoolPool program **to form and maintain carpools** for students, for families without access to/or unwilling to use, school bus transport
- Continued to work with Fairfax County staff in assisting in the **implementation of TDM related proffers** in the DATA service area
