Association Update and Membership Committee Report

DATA President Doug Pickford briefly reviewed current Association activities including status of DATA's grants. He mentioned DATA is proscribed from supporting any TDM strategies other than telework because of the pandemic restrictions so both the vanpool grant and the SchoolPool grant (except for aid to existing school programs) are currently inactive.
